

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS OF THE JOURNAL

The journal "MIR (Modernization. Innovation. Research)" accepts for publication original articles of the theoretical and the empirical nature in all areas of economic science. The journal accepts materials from graduate students, applicants, doctoral students, specialists and experts in this field.

The Journal is included in the List of peer reviewed scientific journals published by the Higher Attestation Commission in which major research results from the dissertations of Candidates of Sciences and Doctor of Science degrees are to be published. The basic rubricator of the journal corresponds to the group of scientific specialties "Economic sciences".

The journal is included in the Russian Index of Science Citation and is a part of its core; it is also indexed in the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI). All articles of the journal are publicly available.

In order to permit complex expert evaluation, all manuscripts undergo double-blind peer review. Articles are published in the journal after being approved by the reviewers and the Editorial Board.

Articles are published free of charge. The journal does not charge the authors for preparing the article for publication, placing it, or printing materials.

All Authors when submitting a manuscript to the journal:

- they should guarantee that the submitted manuscript is an original work, prepared without the use of Generative AI, and all copyrights on it belong to him / her;
- they should disclose in their manuscript any financial or any other existing conflict of interest that might be perceived to influence the results or interpretation of their manuscript;
- they are responsible for the selection and accuracy of the facts, quotations, statistical and sociological data, dates, proper names, geographical names and other information;
- they agree to the terms and conditions of the enclosed Copyright agreement.

The manuscript of the article should be submitted to the editorial office electronically. Please use the form on our website (<http://www.mir-nayka.com>) to submit your article and attach the necessary documents.

Please note that the following documents are required:

- Consent to the processing of personal data – scanned copies in JPEG format;
- Completed Application to the Copyright agreement (public offer) for publication in the journal – scanned copies in JPEG format;
- Checklist form confirming compliance with journal requirements – a scanned copy with the signature of the author;
- Illustrative materials for the article (figures, graphs, diagrams, tables, etc.) are provided in the form of separate files, saved in the format of the program in which they were created.

To publish a scientific article, the author(s) should submit a manuscript and other mandatory documents in exact accordance with the requirements of the journal.

All articles are checked for plagiarism. If plagiarism is identified, the COPE guidelines on plagiarism will be followed.

The structure of article (<http://www.mir-nayka.com>):

- 1) Code of UDC and a code of JEL, Specialty of the Higher Attestation Commission;
- 2) Full Names of authors (in English and Russian);
- 3) Information about the authors (in English and Russian);
- 4) Title of the article – not more than 10 words (in English and Russian);
- 5) Abstract – should be 200-250 words, structured and include sections: Purpose, Methods, Results, Conclusions and Relevance (in English and Russian);
- 6) Keywords – should be 5–7 words on the topic of the article (in English and Russian);
- 7) Acknowledgments (in English and Russian);
- 8) Conflict of Interest (in English and Russian);
- 9) Text of the article – should be structured and include sections: Introduction, Literature Review, Materials and methods, Results, Conclusions and Relevance;
- 10) References – we recommend using of not less than 25–30 sources in an original research article, and not less than 50–80 in scientific review;
- 11) Contribution of Authors (in English and Russian).

The journal "MIR (Modernization. Innovation. Research)" adopted the Vancouver citation style, which uses a "numerical-end-note" approach. Each piece of work which is cited in your text should have a unique number, assigned in the order of citation.

- The source is indicated in the text are given in Arabic numerals in square brackets.
- All the sources in the list of References are listed in the order in which they are mentioned in the text.
